

## HOCKEY



Spartan Stadium at San Jose State University will provide an excellent venue for Hockey in 2012 in the San Francisco Bay Area. Spartan seats approximately 27,000 spectators in a venue that has proven itself in nearly 100 international sports events, including the Women's World Cup in 1999. For the Hockey competition, the field of play will be replaced with a surface selected by the FIH, installed to the most exacting standards and tested thoroughly in coordination with USA Hockey.

In addition, a 5000-seat stadium will be established to the same standards for preliminary competition at the Bud Winter Field, immediately adjacent to Spartan Stadium. A training pitch will also be provided on the grounds.

With its experience in hosting international events, Spartan has facilities already in place for all constituencies, from officials to media and Olympic Family. Its outstanding atmosphere will enhance the exciting competition in 2012.

After the Olympic Games, Spartan Stadium will continue to host collegiate, professional and international sports events.

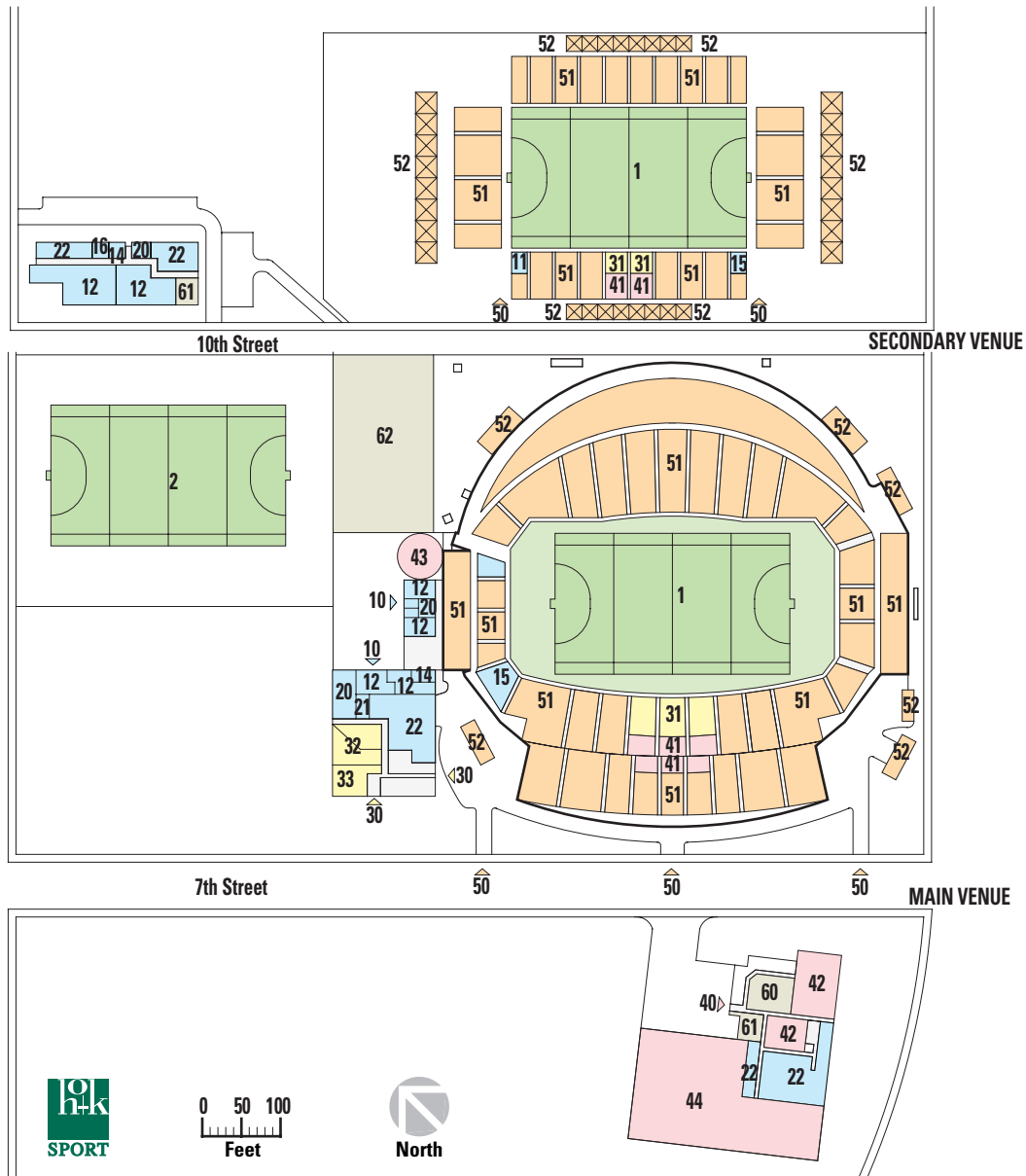

The total number of available seats for Hockey at Spartan Stadium is 27,000, of which 25,850 are reserved for the general public. At the preliminary venue, 5,000 seats are available, of which 4,350 are reserved for the general public.
