

MODERN PENTATHLON



Modern Pentathlon will be staged in an ideal environment for athletes, officials, media and spectators in 2012 in the San Francisco Bay Area. Located in the midst of the Olympic Stadium Cluster at Stanford University, the selected venues are immediately adjacent to one another, less than 200 meters apart.

The Fencing and Shooting competitions will be staged in Maples Pavilion, a venue that provides intimate seating for 7,000 spectators and is renowned for its exciting atmosphere. Maples Pavilion is supported by extensive facilities in Arrillaga Family Sports Center.

Next to Maples Pavilion and Arrillaga Center, the newly renovated Avery Aquatics Complex will host the swimming competition. Avery Complex will also provide 7,000 seats at the home of one of the premier swimming programs in the world, a program that has produced many great Olympic champions.

A one-minute walk from Avery Complex, the famous Sunken Diamond will serve as the venue for the Riding and Running competitions, set up in a manner similar to that used in Sydney. With 10,000 seats available, Sunken Diamond will offer an outstanding atmosphere in a beautiful setting, right next to the Olympic Stadium, the Hospitality Village and the Expo Mall.

These facilities would be available for four days of competition if the UIPM were to decide to feature relay competitions in 2012.

With excellent competition conditions at venues as compact as possible, all located at the heart of the Olympic Games, the Modern Pentathlon will have the showcase that its dedicated, multitalented athletes deserve.

For Modern Pentathlon, BASOC has established Chabot College in Hayward as the training venue. For riding, Portola Valley Riding Center and CTETA in Woodside are both available and within five miles of the competition venue.

After the Olympic Games, the facilities at Stanford University will continue to be used for collegiate athletic training and competition.

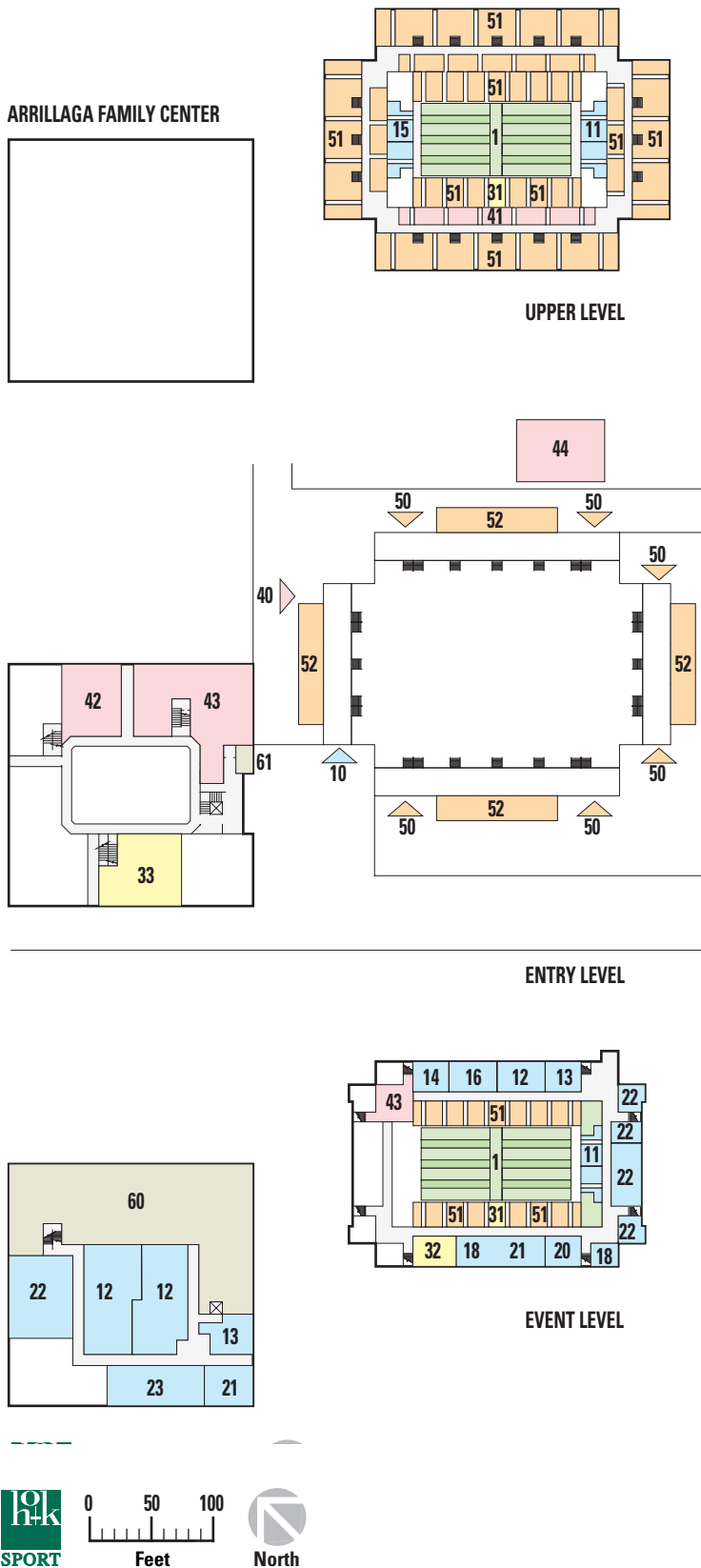
