

## TAEKWONDO



Taekwondo's growing popularity as an Olympic sport suggests the need for a venue in which the athletes can prepare and perform in the best possible circumstances. An intimate yet high-capacity venue would demonstrate how dramatic and exciting Taekwondo is. For this reason, BASOC has selected the new Moscone West Convention Center as the Taekwondo venue for the 2012 Olympic Games.

Under construction today, Moscone West will feature Taekwondo on the first level with over 90,000 square feet and 8,000 seats.

The seating area has been specifically designed in a "bowl" shape to create an exciting atmosphere for the competition. A lounge for the Olympic Family and a subcenter for the press are also located on the first floor, immediately adjacent to their respective seating areas.

Training facilities for the athletes are located on the second floor. Here, BASOC has custom-designed individual cabins for the athletes' use, each approximately 150 square feet, which surround training mats and adjoin the saunas and physiotherapy and lounge facilities. With these specially prepared facilities, the athletes will have ideal conditions to concentrate, train or relax.

Moscone West is located one block from the proposed IOC Hotel at the San Francisco Marriott in downtown San Francisco. Situated in the heart of the Host City, Taekwondo at Moscone West will be at the center of the Olympic Games in 2012.

Three training sites are required for Taekwondo; however, BASOC has identified the following four training venues:

- Piedmont Hills High School, San Jose
- Westmont High School, Campbell
- Mills High School, Millbrae
- Menlo College, Menlo Park

**10.3** *Indicate on a map (giving the scale used) the location of the competition venues mentioned in question 10.1, as well as that of the Olympic Village, the MPC, the IBC, the Judges and Referees Village and the Media Village (if applicable). Indicate on the map the distance in miles, kilometers and travel time (in current and future conditions, and if improvements are planned between these different sites).*

The location of the Taekwondo venue at Moscone Center West is indicated on **Map 10.3 – Taekwondo**. This map also shows the relationship of the venue to the Olympic Village, the MPC, the IBC, the Judges and Referees Village, the Media Hotel Cluster and the Media Village.

- 10.4.4** Name of current owner (and of future owner if venue is to change hands) and current status of agreements with owners concerning use if site for the Olympic Games, indicating whether these are already signed or to be negotiated (in accordance with the guarantees given in Section 9.1.5).

After the Olympic Games, Moscone Center West will continue to serve as a convention center for conferences, exhibitions and other public gatherings.

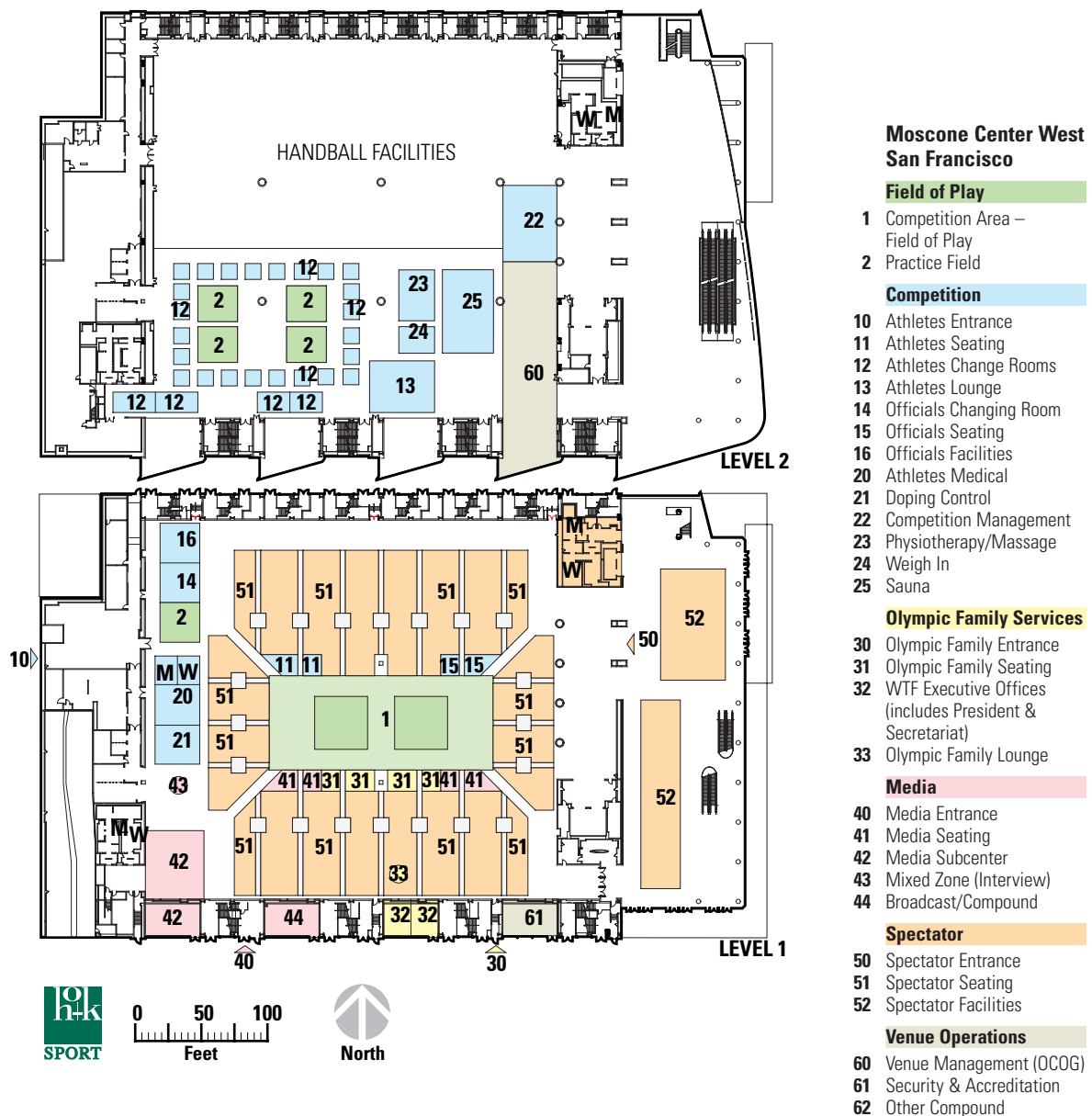
10.7 For each venue (according to its use for the Olympic Games) give the following information:

### 10.7.2 Capacity for Olympic Games

The total number of available seats for Taekwondo at Moscone West is 8,000, of which 7,100 are reserved for the general public.
