

WRESTLING



The great tradition of Olympic Wrestling in the United States deserves a major venue to enable more spectators to attend the competition than ever before. The San Jose Convention Center will provide such a place.

BASOC has developed plans for a 13,000-seat venue in the San Jose Convention Center. The seating is designed as an enclosed bowl to promote a sense of intimacy and intensity, with outstanding sightlines, and to create an unprecedented atmosphere for the Wrestling competition in the 2012 Olympic Games in the San Francisco Bay Area.

The athletes will also be provided a superb environment that includes custom-designed individual cabins situated around the saunas and the weigh-in area, adjacent to the training mats – optimum conditions in which to prepare for their matches.

The San Jose Convention Center, located in the heart of Silicon Valley in downtown San Jose, is a modern facility with substantial dedicated spaces available for other Olympic Family members, including a press subcenter, media lounge and Olympic Family Lounge. Spectators will also enjoy the spacious foyer.

In the adjacent plaza, spectators and Olympic enthusiasts visiting San Jose will be treated to an Olympic Festival to add another dimension to their Olympic experience. Travel to and from the venue will be easy because the San Jose Convention Center offers a stop on the VTA Light Rail and is also a short walk from Caltrain.

After the Olympic Games, the San Jose Convention Center will continue to function as a convention center for conferences, exhibitions, trade shows and other events.

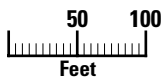
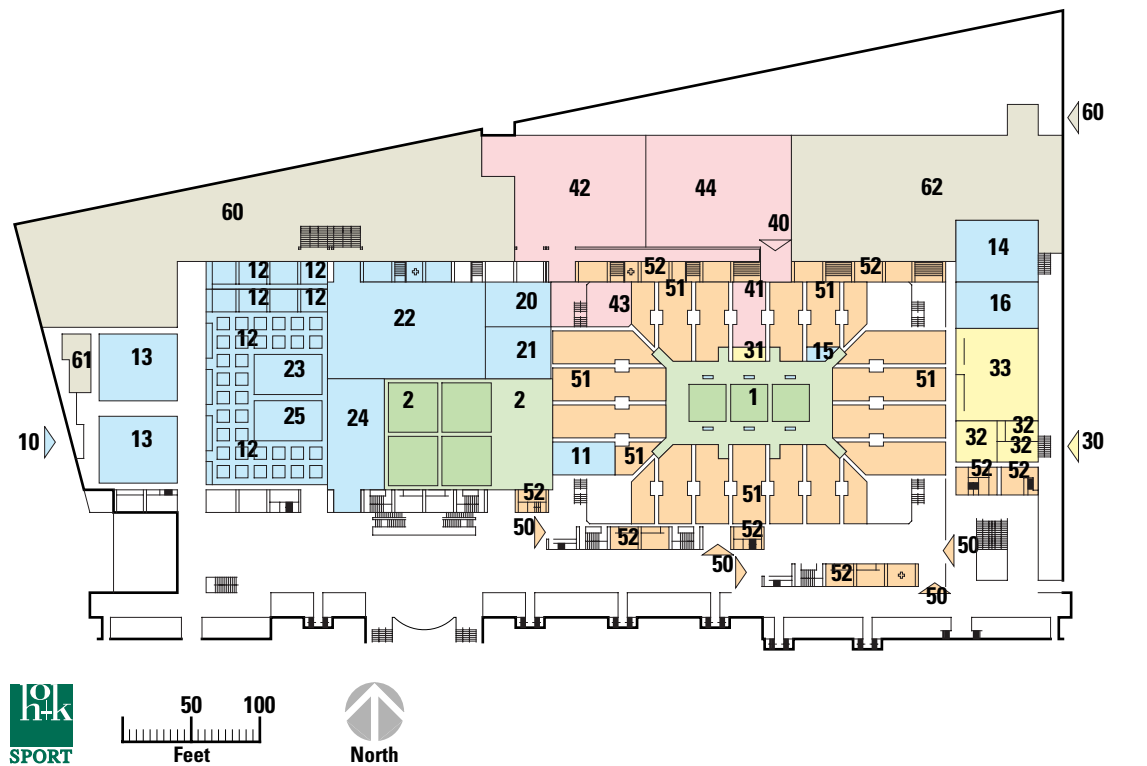
